Following their return from vacation, John set up a business with two of his friends and obtained a metal fabricating company in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania. Starting with a small crew of twenty personnel, they produced and sold their first JLG aerial work platform in 1970. The business incorporates some of the simple design elements of that original lift into existing models.

Since then, JLG Forklifts have come a long way from when Mr. John L. Grove came back from his fatefull cross-country journey and since the first JLG aerial platform entered the market.
